THANKS FOR SHOWING UP!

1. This is a peaceful protest. **Please don't yell back at passersby** or engage with naysayers. They want a negative reaction, so just smile and wave.
2. This is a 1st Amendment assembly. We have a constitutionally protected right to protest on the public sidewalk as long as we do not stop people from passing us or block businesses. We do not have a permit to be in the street. **Please don't stand in the road.** Drivers might not expect you to be there.
3. Our first concern is safety. **Please follow the directions of our peacekeepers** and crossing guards. Please do not cross the road, except at crosswalks. Please do not run across the middle of the road.
